Ying Liu received her PhD in Microbiology in 2015 from the Wuhan University, China, where she gained expertise on genetics and molecular biology. She continued her training as a postdoctoral researcher at the Institut Pasteur, France, where she explored the diversity of archaeal virosphere from extreme environments and investigated molecular mechanisms of archaeal virus-host interactions with David Prangishvili and Mart Krupovic. In 2024, she became a staff member of the Faculty of College of Life Sciences at the Wuhan University. She joined the ICTV *Pleolipoviridae* Study Group and *Portogloboviridae* Study Group in 2021.

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
