

Dr Stephen Sharpe served as chair of the ICTV *Xinmoviridae* study group from 2024 to 2026, leading updates to the ICTV Taxonomy Report and the development of Taxonomy Proposals. As a member of the *Xinmoviridae* study group from 2021 to 2023, he also contributed to the first ICTV Taxonomy Report on *Xinmoviridae*.

From 2024 to 2026, he was a Postdoctoral Researcher (CERC Fellow) at the Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organisation (CSIRO) in Australia, where he investigated virus interactions to develop superinfection exclusion strategies for the control of mosquito-borne infections. His main research interests are in host-pathogen and virus interactions, microbial ecology, and pathogen diagnostics, characterisation and taxonomy through laboratory and bioinformatic approaches.

He completed his PhD in 2022 at Western Sydney University, Australia, investigating insect-specific RNA virus diversity, prevalence and host effects in Australian tephritid fruit flies. Prior to this, he completed an MSc by Research in Biosciences in 2016 and a BSc (Hons) in Conservation Biology and Ecology at the University of Exeter, UK.
