Title of proposal: Rename the two species in the genus "PhiKMV-like viruses" (proposed name *Phikmvlikevirus*)

Text of proposal:

Change the names of the following two species in the genus "PhiKMV-like viruses": Enterobacteria phage phiKMV to Pseudomonas phage phiKMV; Enterobacteria phage LKA1 to Pseudomonas phage LKA1.

Reasons to justify the proposal:

The genus 'PhiKMV-like viruses' (subfamily *Autographivirinae*, family *Podoviridae*, order *Caudovirales*) and two species were created by proposal 2007.110-114B. The species were named *Enterobacteria phage phiKMV*, and *Enterobacteria phage LKA1* and this is how they appear in the MSL. These were proposed (and ratified) in error and they should have been named *Pseudomonas phage phiKMV*, and *Pseudomonas phage LKA1*, respectively. The correct names reflect the host bacterium and are also consistent with the literature and information in the sequence accessions
